KING MATT THE FIRST – Technical Rider*

Required:

- A space that can be darkened with access to electrical outlets (traditional American three-prong plugs with AC or with adapters The standard voltage is 120 V and the standard frequency is 60 Hz.)
- Plugs for the lighting in front of the set (two light trees supplied) and the projector and player in rear (see photo)
- Performance area: at least 24 feet wide, 15 feet deep, 10 feet high
- For sightlines: theatrical seating preferred; if not, the rear of the theater could be elevated
- Best viewing capacity: 150 per show
- Strongly recommend an audience of ages 8 and older
- Performance time: 55 minutes with an option for a "talk back" afterwards

We supply everything including sound – requirements:

It is helpful to have extra hands for load-in, set-up and tear-down


The facility is responsible for monitoring the house, handling tickets, etc. for the performance.


